Princess Vine / Season Vine (*Cissus verticillata*)

Princess vine is a large woody vine, frequently climbing over tall trees. The stems are thick, tough and very flexible. The leaves have a large variation and are 1.5"-6" long. The firm tendrils grow opposite of some leaves. The small flowers are green or yellow and grow in clusters. Each of the round black fruit have one seed inside. **This invasive vine will quickly cover many trees. It will blanket forest canopies and restrict plant growth. It is a known agricultural weed to citrus crops.** *Let's stop it before it becomes a problem on Kaua'i.*

What can you do?

KISC will be in your area conducting property surveys. If you believe that you have seen this plant, record its location (GPS if possible), try to collect it, and **call KISC at 808/821-1490**. Since this pest is known to only have low distribution on the island, it is important to report it. We will be happy to help with identification, survey, and possible removal of this pest.
